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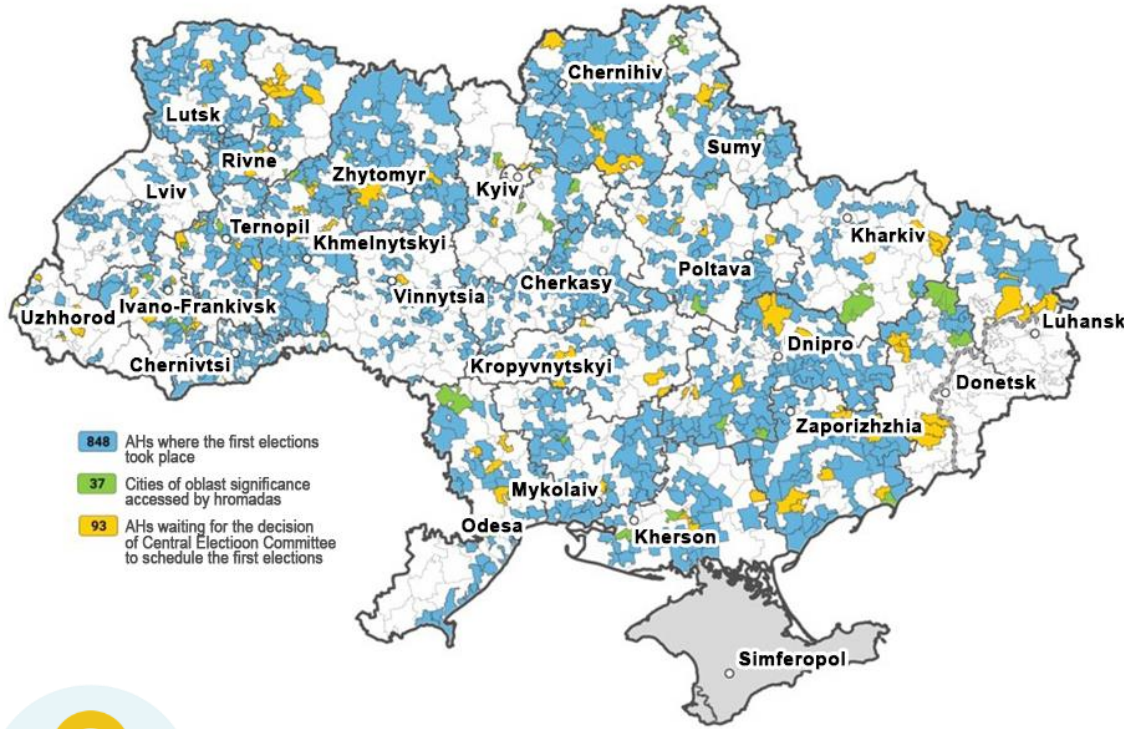
The Government approved prospective plans of hromada territories in **23** oblasts

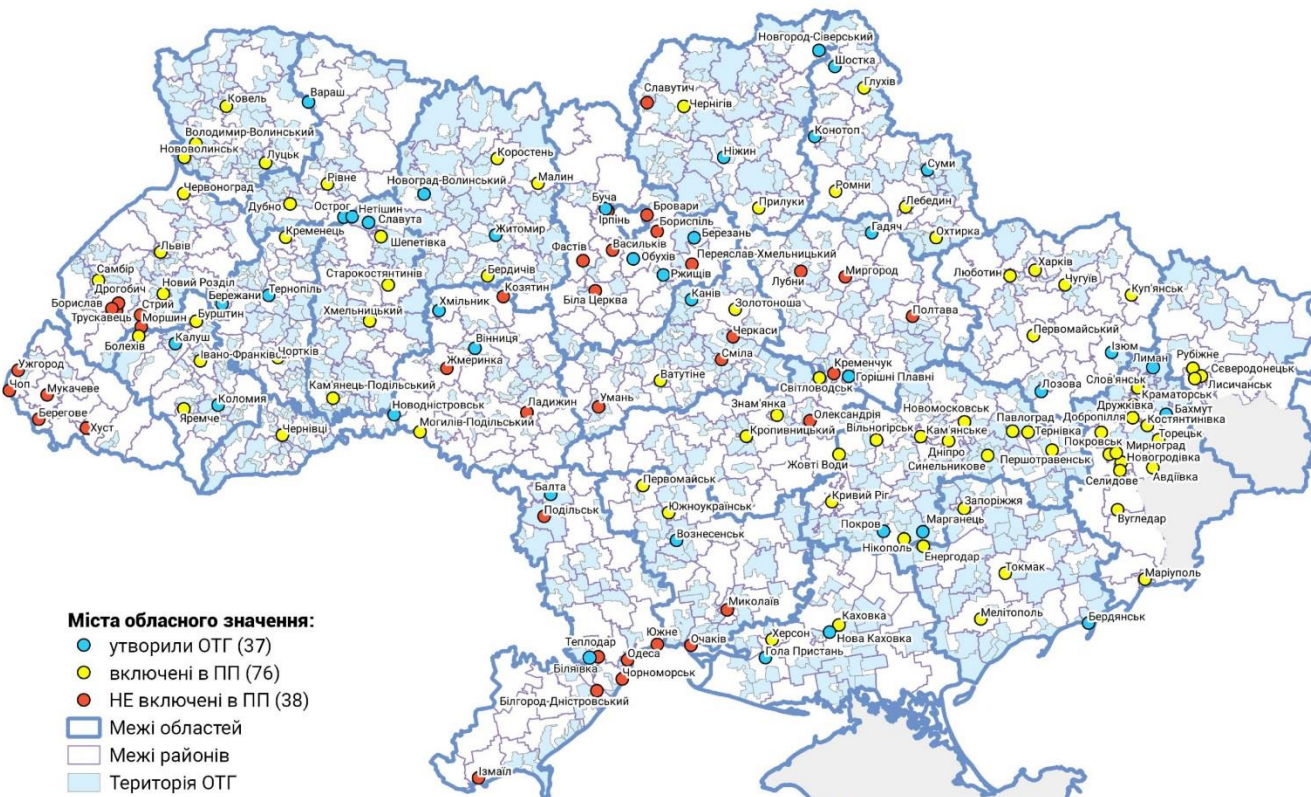

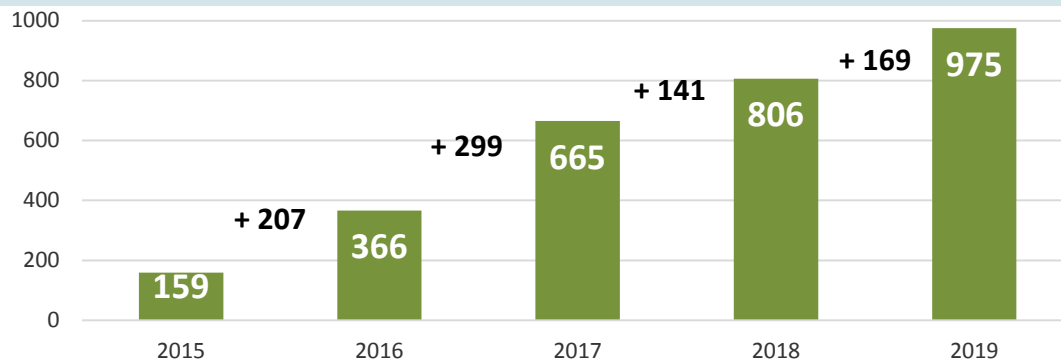

NUMBER OF AMALGAMATED HROMADAS

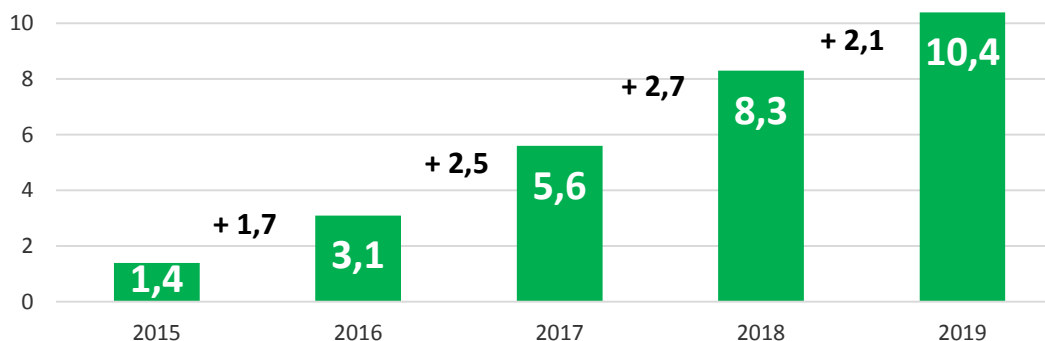

NUMBER OF RESIDENTS IN AMALGAMATED HROMADAS (M people)



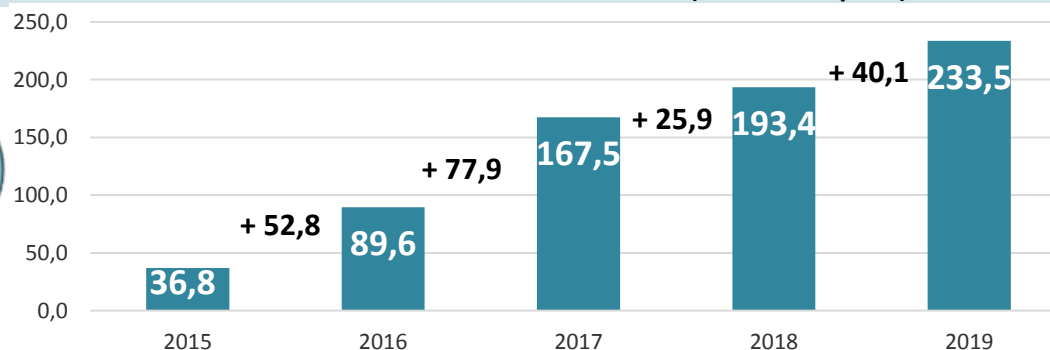

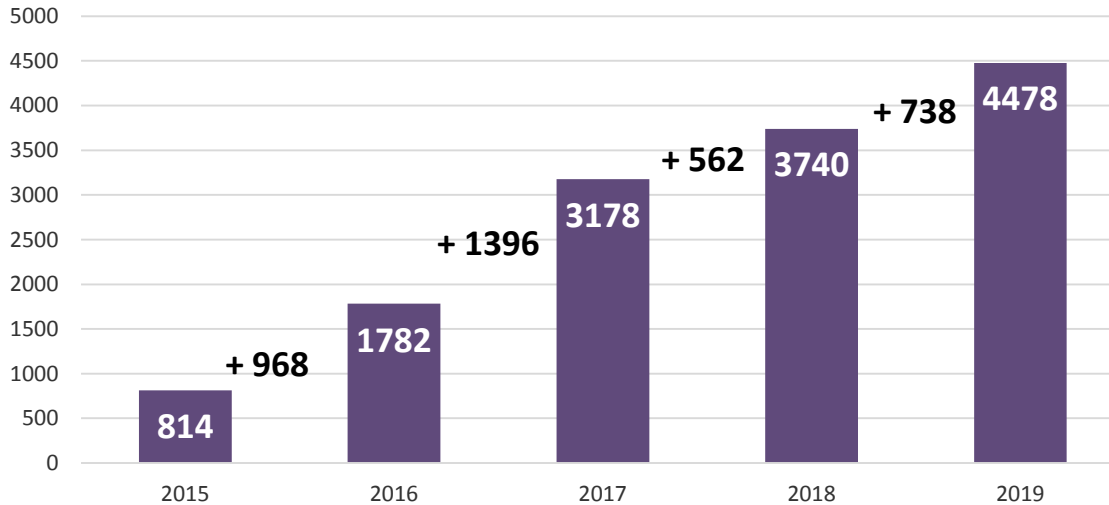

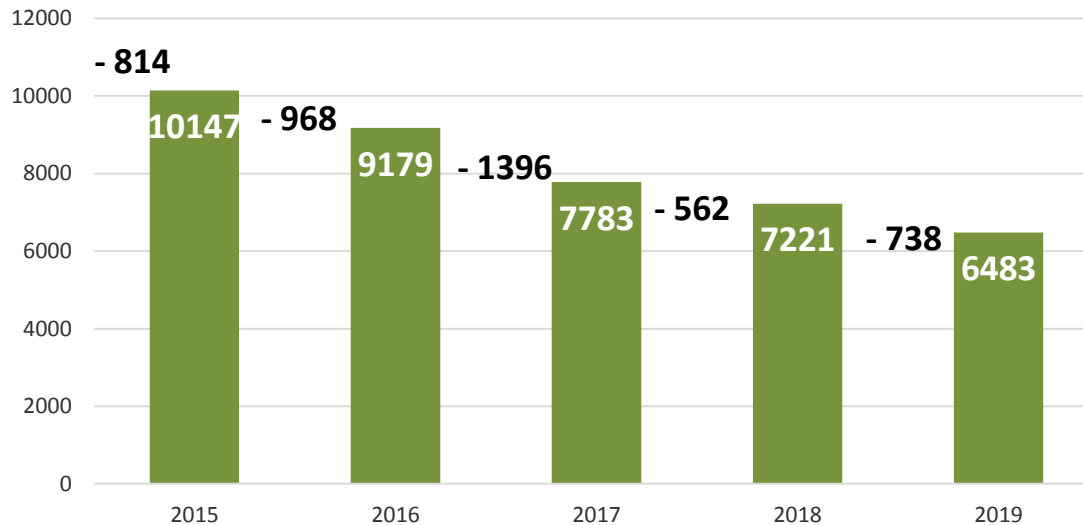

NUMBER OF NON-AMALGAMATED AND NON-ACCESSED HROMADAS



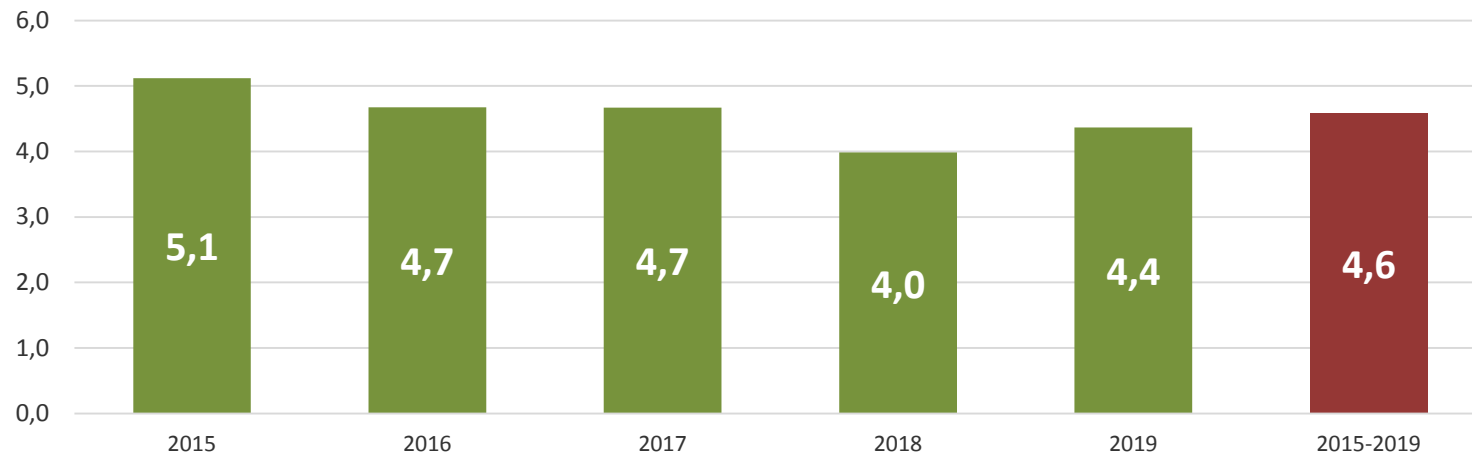

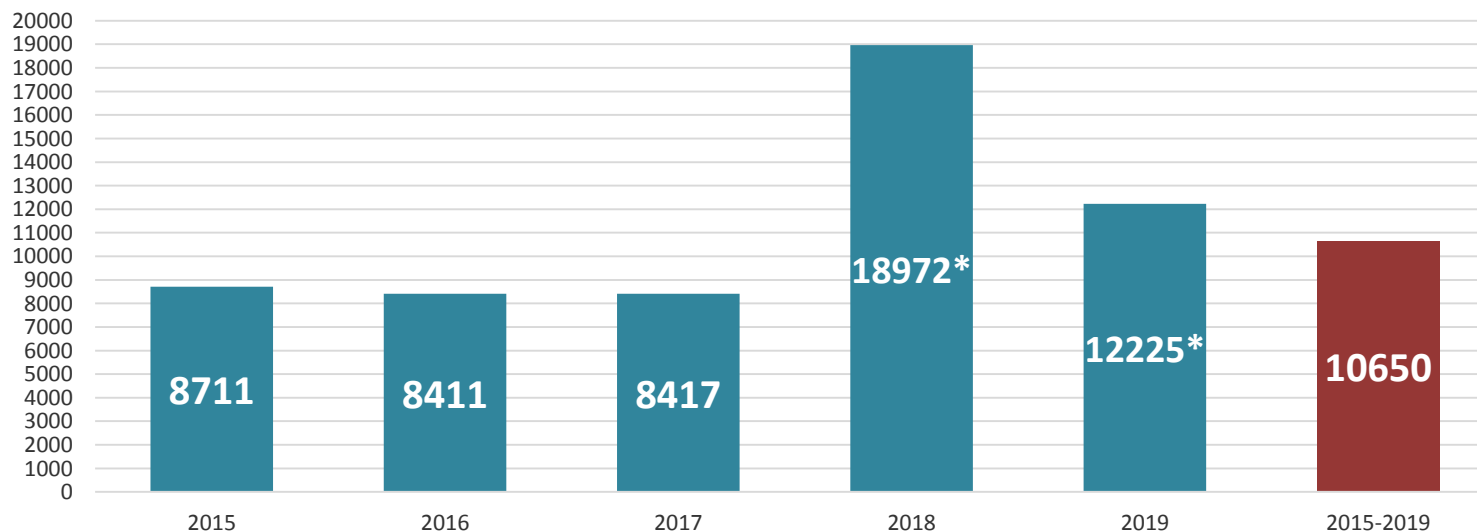

Average number of hromadas , which amalgamated into one AH

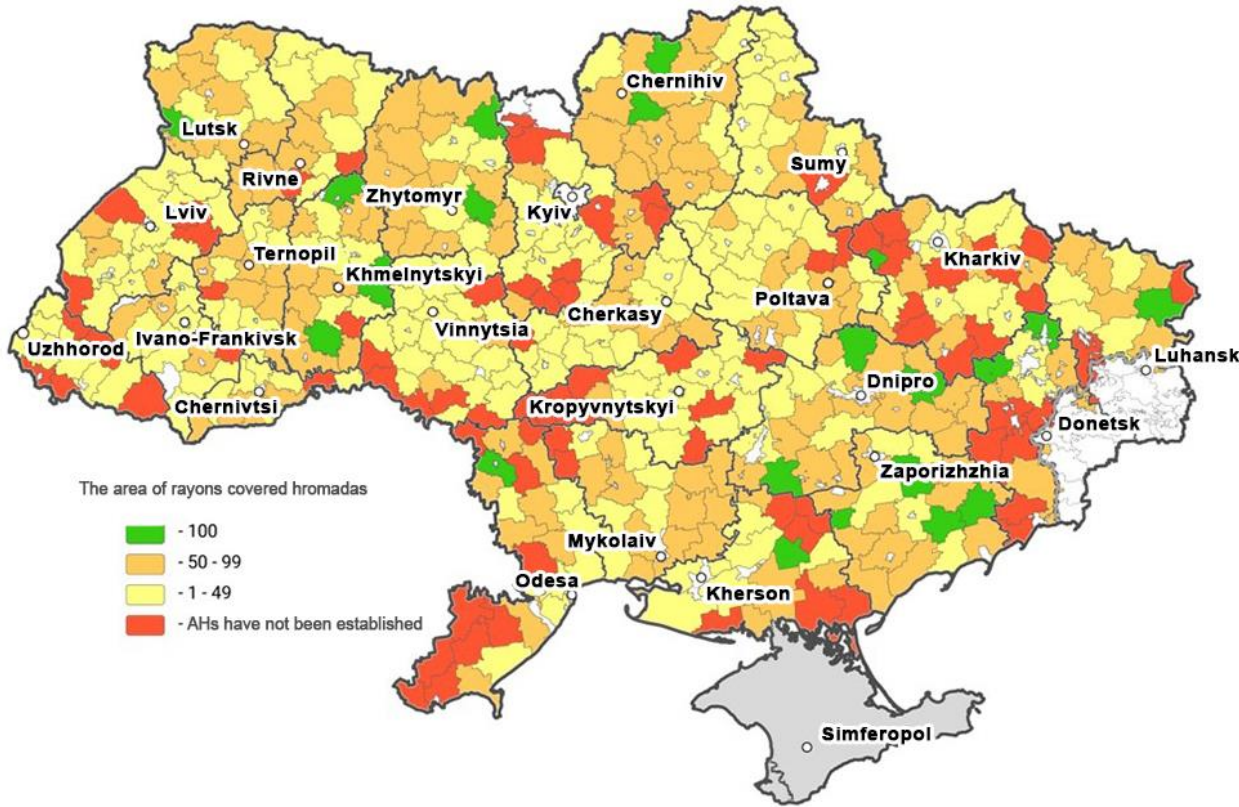

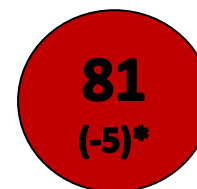
Rayons where 100% Territories covered by AHs



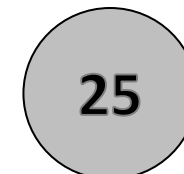
Rayons with 50...99% Territories covered by AHs

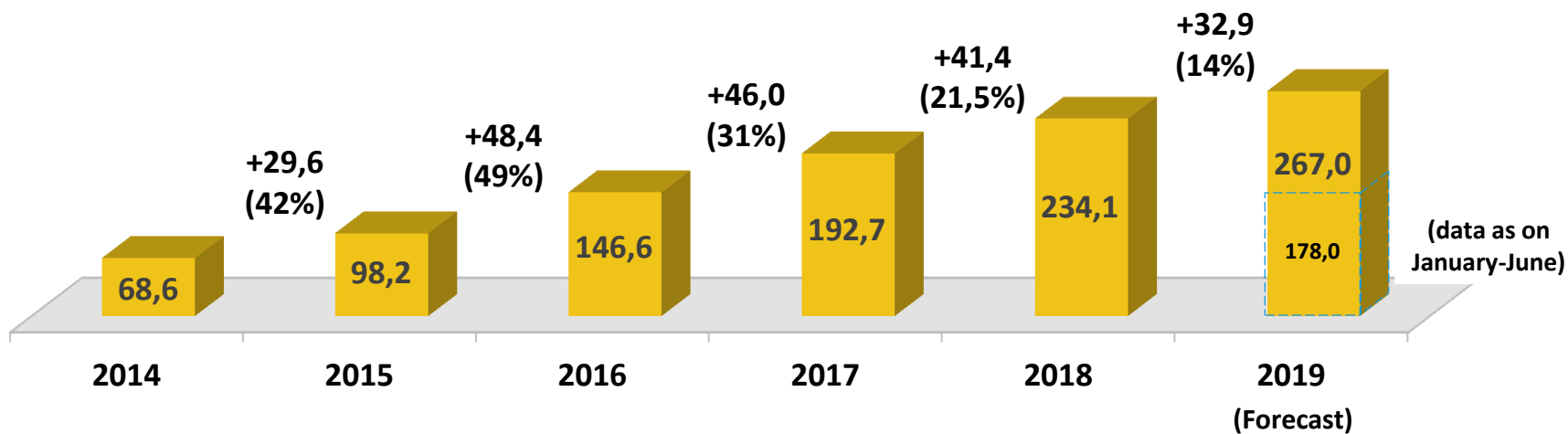

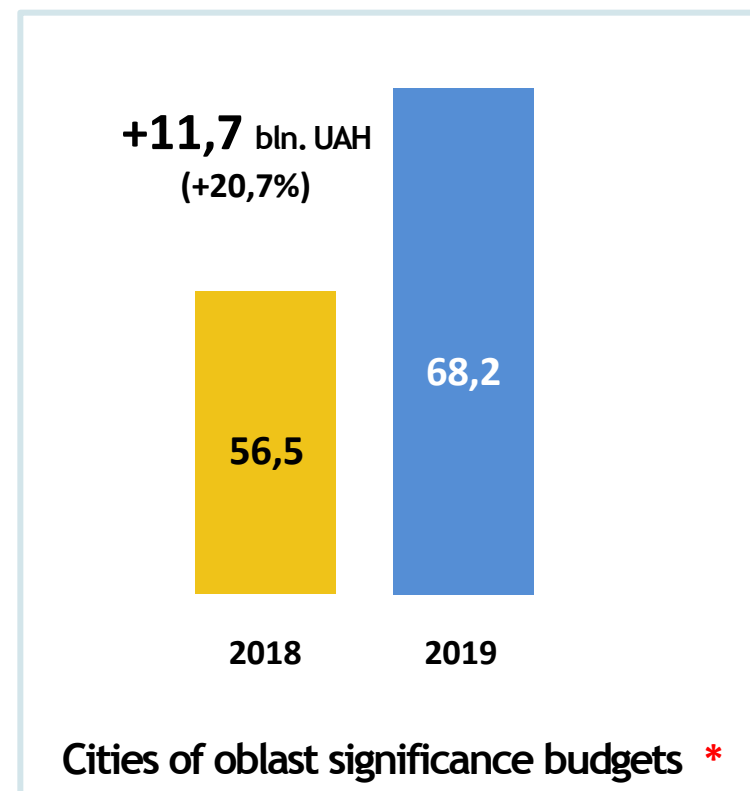
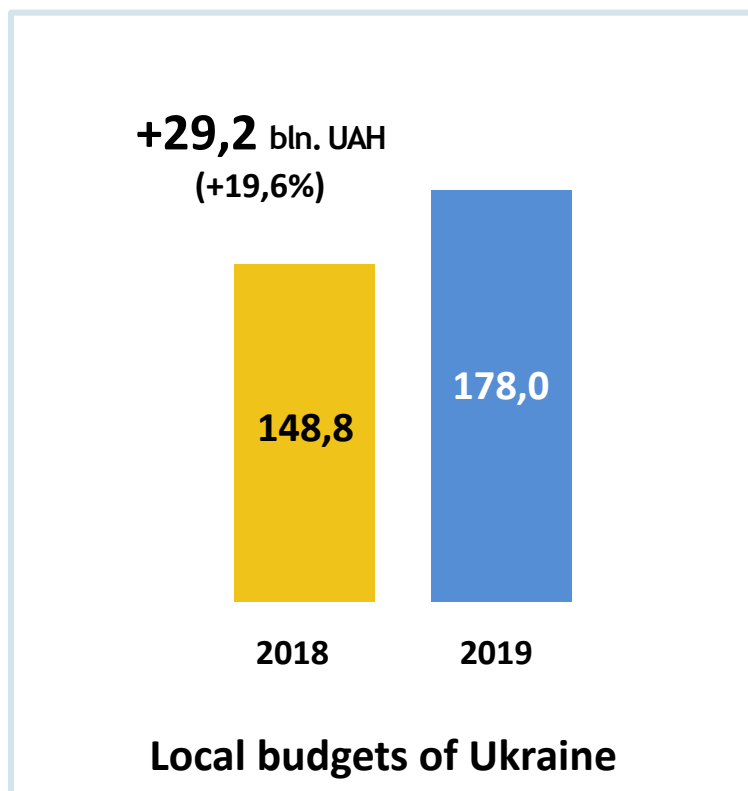
Local budget own revenue (general fund) share in GDP, %



Local budget general fund own revenue, bln. UAH.

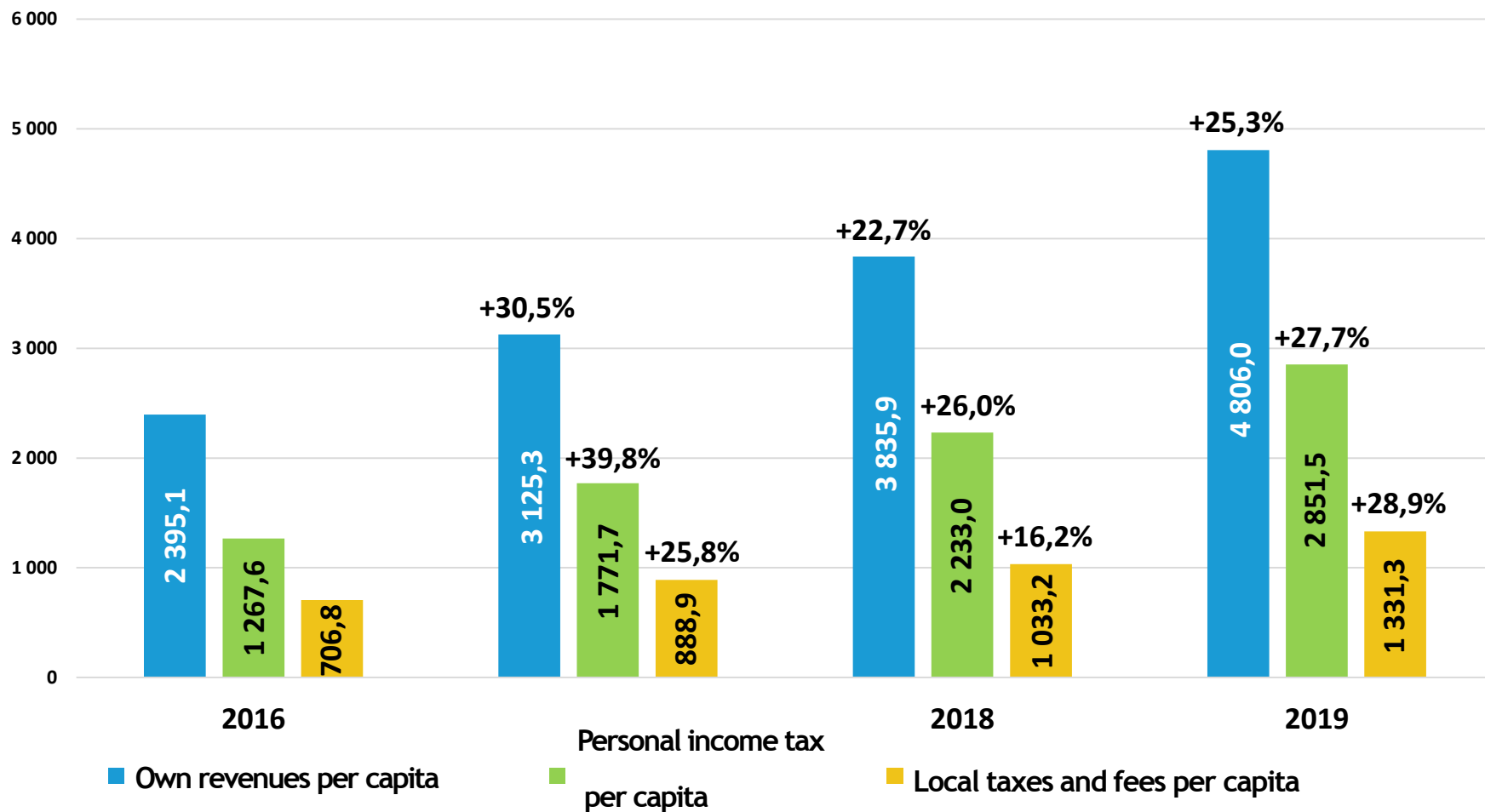


Execution of local budget revenues in January – August 2019 , compared to
January – August 2018, bln UAH (%)

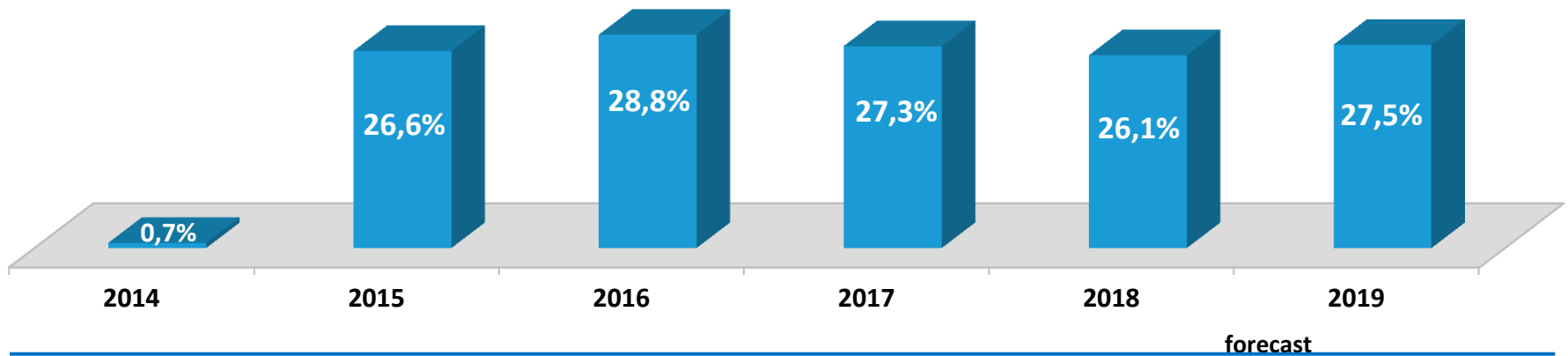

Growth rate of local budgets general fund revenue per capita for January- August 2016-2019, % and UAH

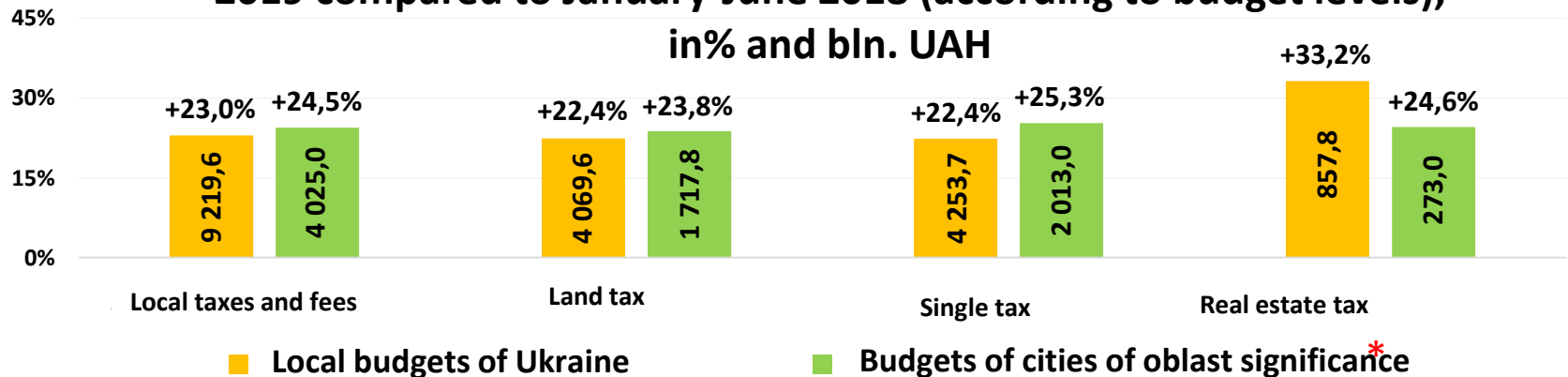


Share of local taxes and fees in the local budgets own revenues (general fund), %



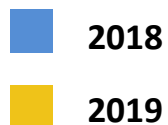
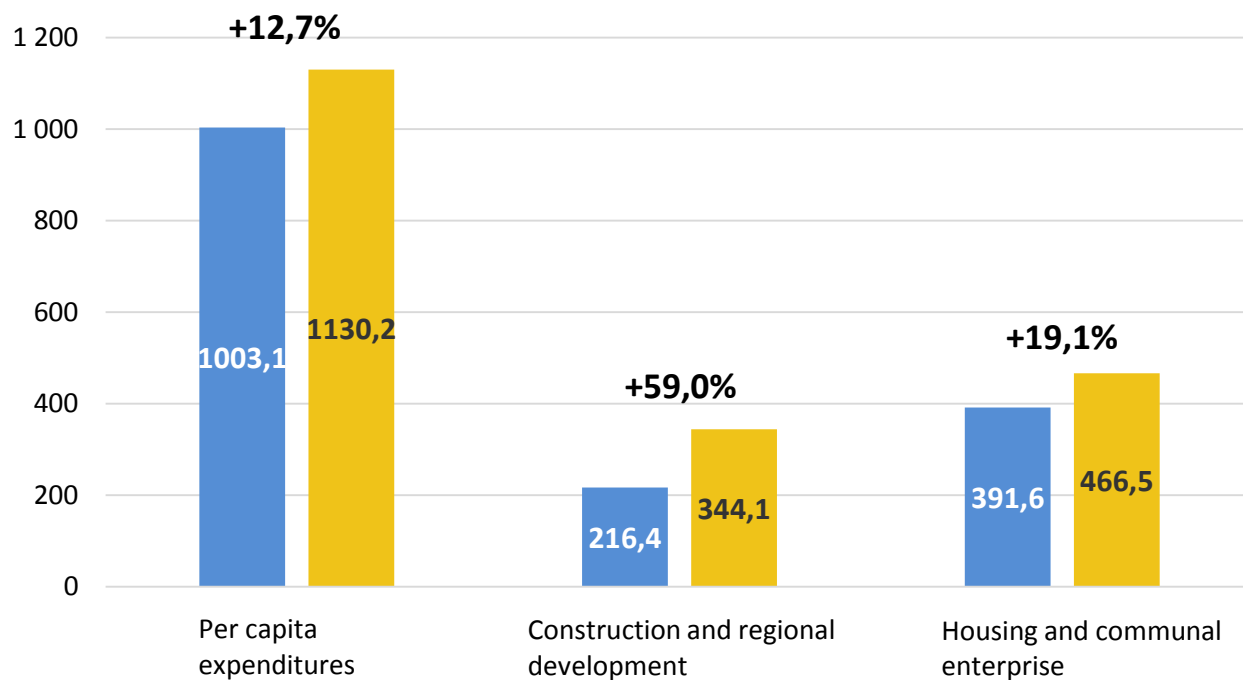
Growth rate of local taxes and fees in local budgets in January - June

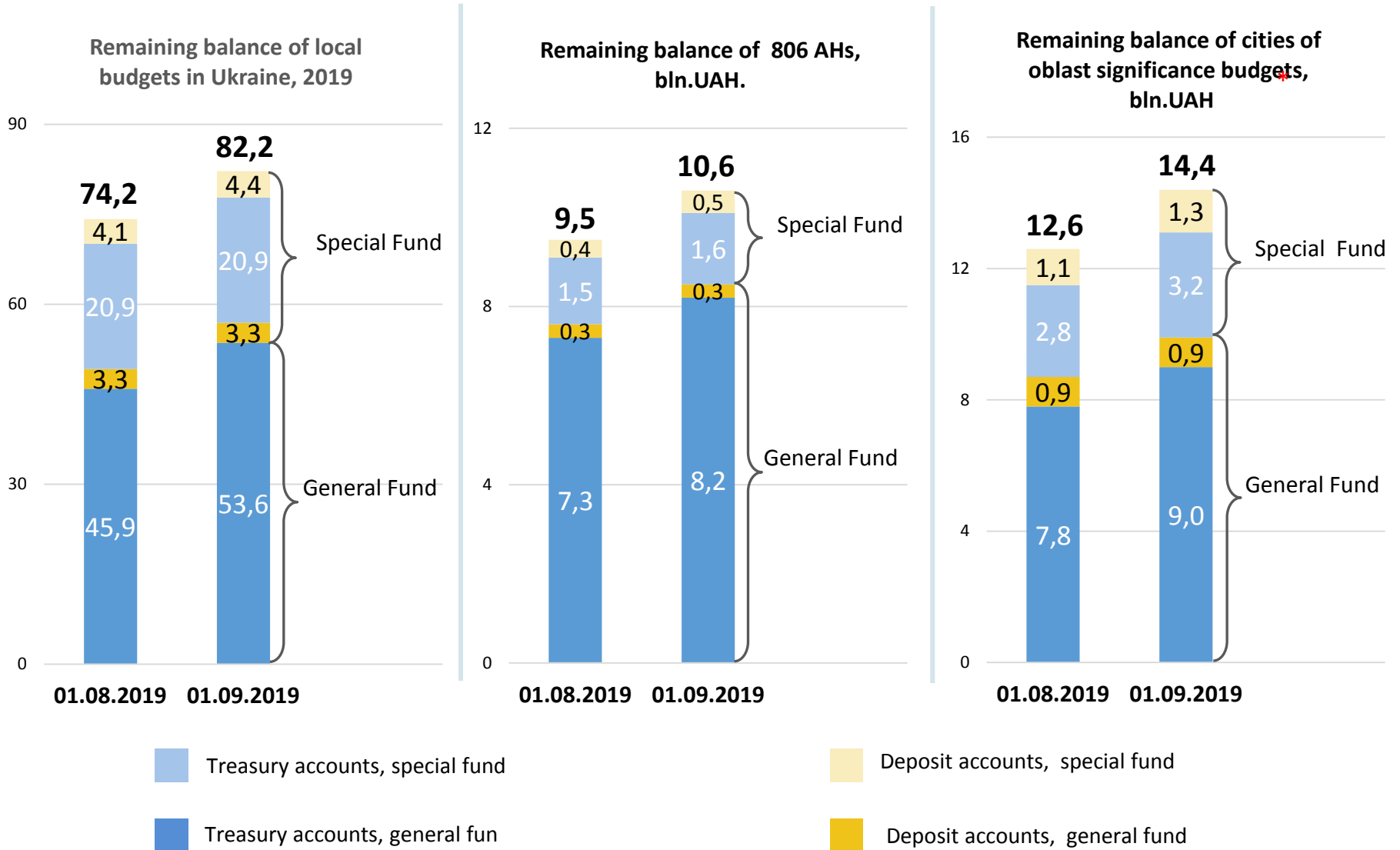
2019 compared to January-June 2018 (according to budget levels), in% and bln. UAH

Expenditures per capita for January-July 2018 and 2019 per capita, UAH





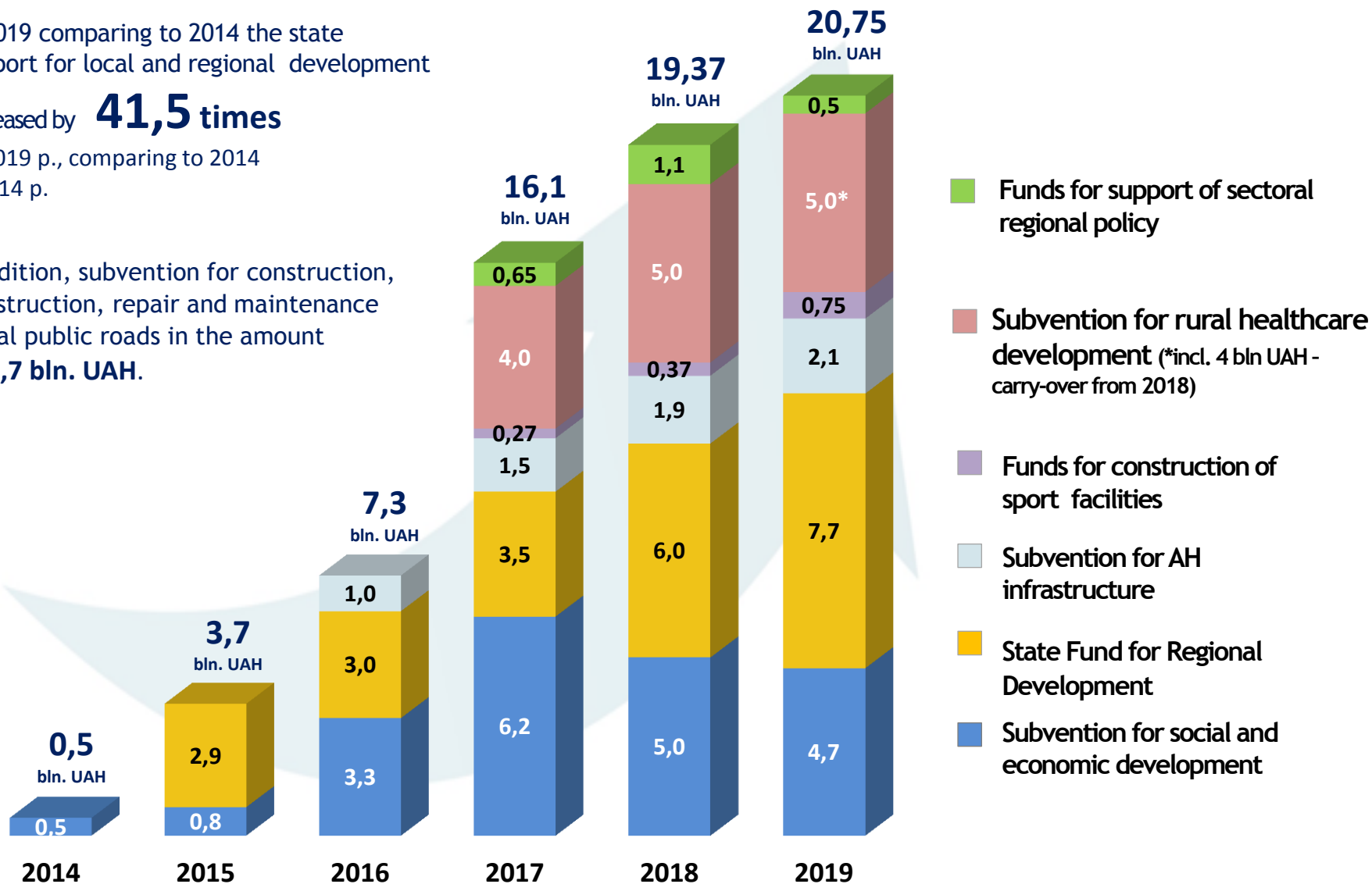

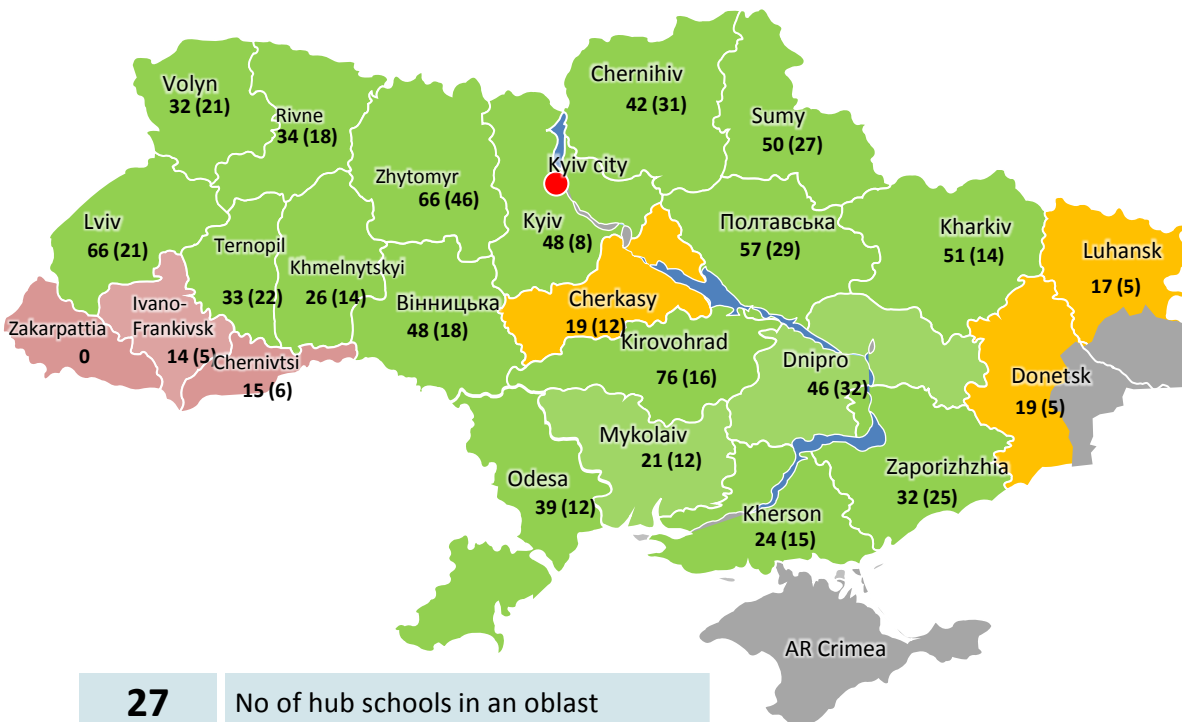

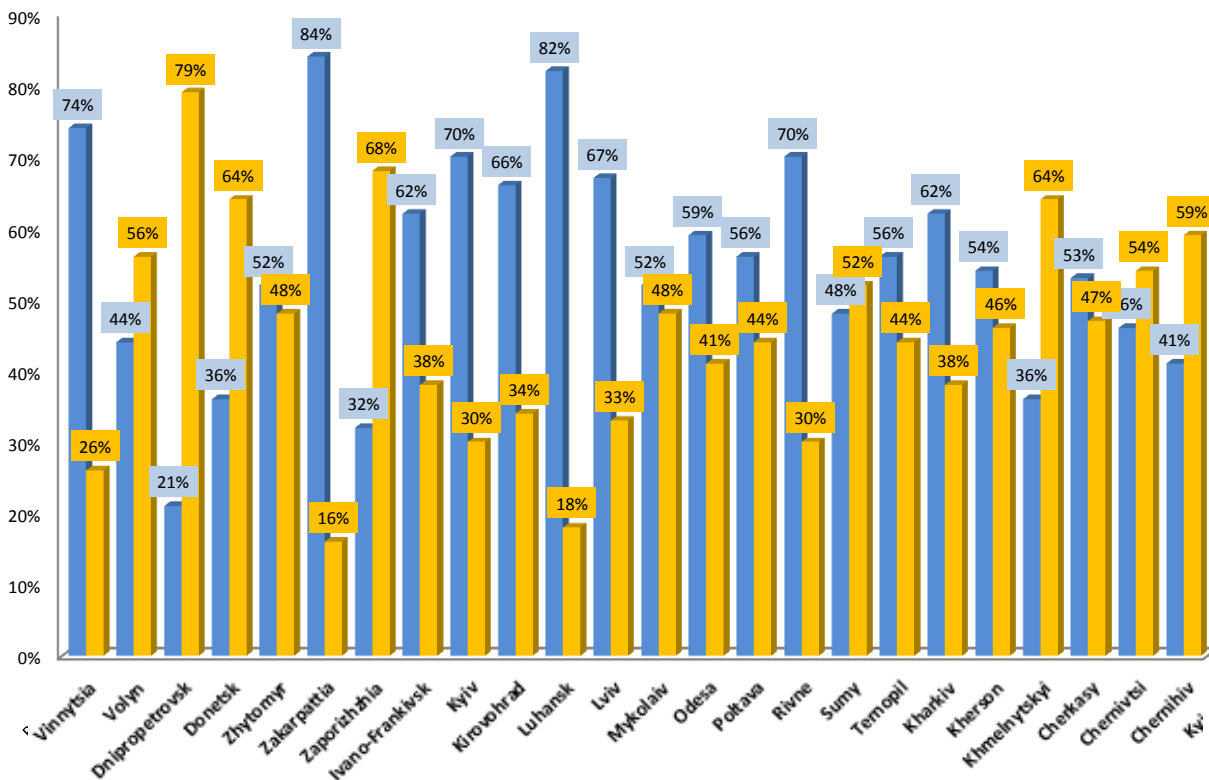

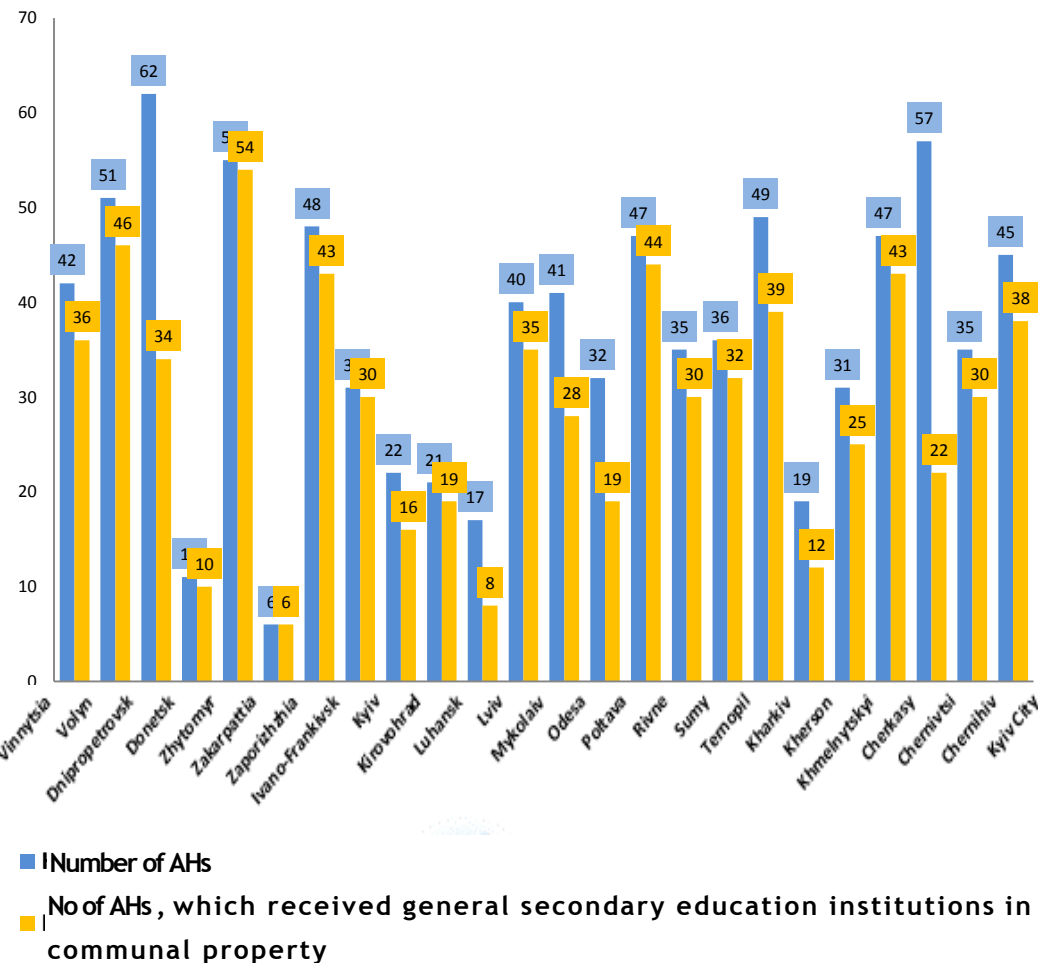

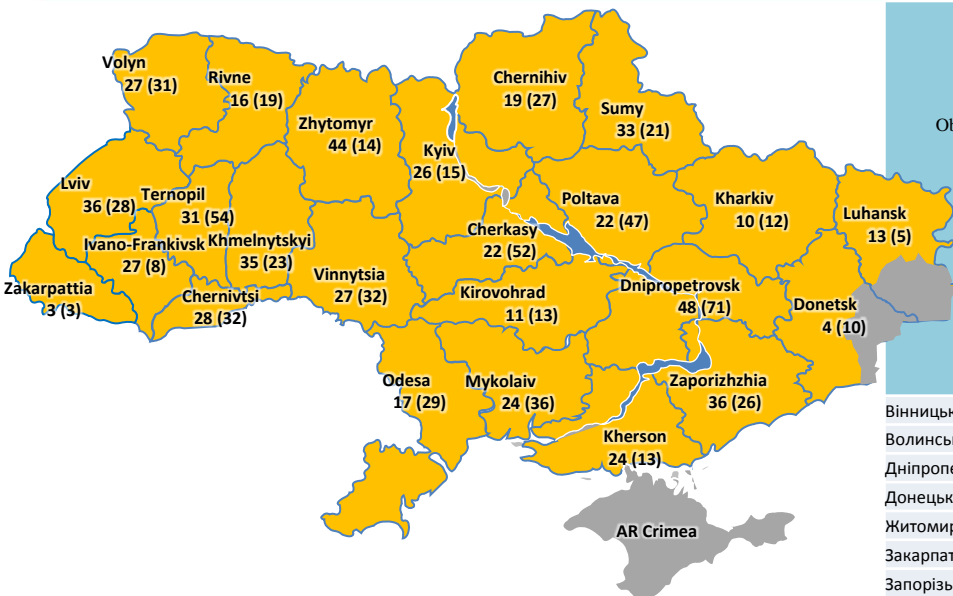
